In its efforts to combat the impact of demonetization on the handicrafts sector and to facilitate timely payment to the most effected, EPCH has taken the initiative for opening of bank accounts and Jan Dhan Accounts for karigars and artisans. Camps were set up in various craft clusters like Agra, Saharanpur, Moradabad, Guwahati, Kolkata, Narsapur and Barmer, through the month of December. Towards this endeavour, Nationalised Oriental Bank of Commerce sent a team to facilitate opening of bank accounts as well as counsel crafts persons on benefits of cashless transactions as well as online payments, mobile banking (services like paytm, buddy, e-wallet etc.). A cashless transactions firm - Paytm also joined the movement and set up its information kiosk during some of the camps.
